
Septic Tank Pumpers

When choosing a septic tank pumper, the price quoted should include completely pumping both sides of the tank. If your septic tank has an effluent pump, it will need to be removed prior to pumping to enable your pumper to thoroughly clean both compartments of your tank. There is no need to purchase additives for your septic tank; what naturally goes into your septic tank is the best additive.
